ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

(General Laws, Chapter 180)

ARTICLE I

The exact name of the corporation is

The Friends of Cabot Woods, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following activities

The purpose of this corporation is charitable; to preserve environmental quality in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The activities of this corporation will be to that end. These activities will include monitoring and investigating the quality of the environment in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the activities of any parties whose actions may effect the quality of the environment in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. These activities will also include negotiation with appropriate and relevant parties as needed to protect the quality of the environment in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and litigation as a party plaintiff to enforce environmental legislation in order to preserve the quality of the environment of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. These activities will also include any other lawful actions deemed necessary by the Board of Directors for the preservation and/ or protection of the quality of the environment in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under Massachusetts General Law

This corporation has no members.

ARTICLE III

Other lawful provisions, if any, shall be subject to and regulation of the business and affairs of the corporation. Any voluntary dissolution or reformation or reorganizing the powers of the corporation or its members or of any class of members, are as follows:

ARTICLE IV

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 513(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE VI

The effective date of organization of the corporation shall be the date approved and filed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. If a later effective date is desired, specify such date which shall not be more than *thirty days* after the date of filing.

ARTICLE VII

The information contained in Article VII is not a permanent part of the Articles of Organization.



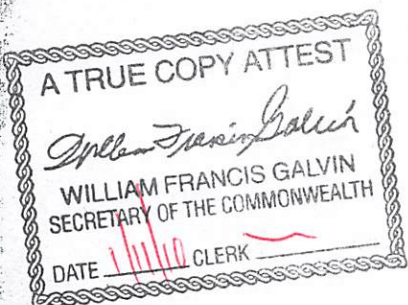
